For both the Bachelor of Arts and the Bachelor of Science, a 3rd writing course must be taken. You may choose from 367.02, 613, 614, or other advisor approved course.

Also of Note

- 613 and 614 can double count for the history GEC and third writing course. See your advisor for approval.
- Statistics 145 & 245 and Math 151 & 152 do not count towards the Economics minor.
- Also consider taking our honors research course, H596.
- The more math classes taken, the better off you will be—especially if you plan to pursue graduate studies in Economics.
- Honors theses are required in order to graduate with *distinction*.
